

ACADEMIC COOPERATION PROTOCOL BETWEEN KYRGYZ-TURKISH MANAS UNIVERSITY AND



ANDIJAN INSTITUTE OF AGRICULTURE AND AGROTECHNOLOGIES

Kyrgyz-Turkish Manas University and Andijan Institute of Agriculture and Agrotechnologies have agreed to pursue the future establishment of a formal collaborative relationship between the two universities, hereafter referred to as "the Parties".

ARTICLE 1

The Parties agree to develop collaboration in the following fields:

- 1. Joint research activities among scientists of the two Parties;
- 2. Exchange of academic staff, researchers and fellows of the two Parties for periods up to one year or longer periods to be determined by mutual consent;
- 3. Exchange of undergraduate and postgraduate students for periods to be defined by the two Parties;
- 4. Cooperation in organizing seminars, courses, workshops and other scientific meetings;
- 5. Co-edition of scientific publications, scientific journals and other materials for education and research purposes.
- 6. Exchange of information, publications, scientific journals and other materials for education and research purposes.

ARTICLE 2

Exchange of staff will be carried out in conformity with the person/month quota to be agreed by the two Parties. Staff will be selected on the basis of mutual agreement. Candidates proposed by one Party will be presented to the other Party in due course, before the beginning of the budget year.

ARTICLE 3

The Parties will assure the visiting staff necessary assistance during their visit. The sending Party will cover foreign and domestic travel costs. The receiving Party will cover local boarding expenses.

ARTICLE 4

The two Parties will exchange undergraduate and post graduate students on a mutually agreed basis in scientific and academic fields of interest. The number of students and the fields of interest will be determined on the basis of mutually agreed Programs. These Programs will be finalized a year before the beginning of the following budget year. Each Party will provide administrative support to these Programs. To this end, each Party will provide orientation and training, administrative assistance and coordination to guest students.

ARTICLE 5

Exchange students will demonstrate their knowledge of the foreign language according to the regulation in force of the receiving Party. Names of selected students, their area of studies and estimated dates of their arrival will be communicated by the sending Party to the receiving Party not later than six months prior to the beginning of the visits. Exchanges will start after the final confirmation of the acceptance of the receiving Party.

ARTICLE 6

Both institutions agree to look into the possibility of exchanging publications that are published by faculty including academic journals, teaching and educational materials, and scientific research. It is also agreed that both institutions may, if convenient, render mutual academic and educational support and assistance, insofar as it might be possible, including obtaining relevant information, equipment and resources for teaching, and data for educational research.

ARTICLE 7

This protocol is written in English in 2 (two) copies and will be ratified after it has been signed by the administration of both universities and approved by the competent authorities.

ARTICLE 8

This protocol will be automatically extended for a period of 5 (five) years unless one of the parties notifies the other party in writing form at least 6 (six) months prior to the expiration date of the termination of the protocol.

ARTICLE 9

In the case of the termination of this protocol, it is guaranteed that the programs and activities that have been started and are being carried out will be continued and completed in accordance with the current terms of the protocol.
